CONSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

Palm Springs Vintage Market will be referred to as "PSVM"

1. The consignor is the owner of all goods consigned to PSVM and has the legal right to enter into this Consignment Agreement.
2. PSVM retains the right to accept or decline any item for consignment at their sole discretion (see list of generally accepted items). PSVM further retains the right to display items for sale as they see fit.
3. Consignor must present all items in saleable condition between 7-8:00AM to the PSVM Consignment Booth, on the day of sale.
4. Consignor is responsible for retrieving unsold items of consignment no later than 4:00PM from the PSVM Consignment Booth, on the day of sale. Any items not retrieved by this time will be donated to a charity of PSVM's choice.
5. Consignor is limited to no more than five (5) items per sale day. The Consignor may set the list price of their items or authorize PSVM to price items on their behalf.
6. PSVM collects a commission on all goods sold equal to forty (40) % of the sale price of items.
7. PSVM accepts cash and credit cards for purchase of Consignor items. Consignor will be paid by check within 10 business days after sale date.
8. PSVM is not responsible for loss, theft or damage to Consignor goods from any cause whatsoever. Insurance coverage remains the sole responsibility of the Consignor.

Delivery of goods to PSVM Consignment Booth constitutes the Consignor's acceptance of the above stated terms. The Consignor signature constitutes the Consignors acknowledgement and understanding of PSVM sales and consignment policies and procedures.

GENERALLY ACCEPTED ITEMS

Furniture, Interior and Exterior Accessories and Furnishings, Art, Jewelry, Clothing, classic vehicles and bikes.

VINTAGE:

Vintage means that the item exhibits the best of a certain quality, or qualities, associated with or belonging to that specific era. In other words, for the term vintage to accurately apply to it, an item should be somewhat representational and recognizable as belonging to the era in which it was made." **Vintage should not be used in reference to objects less than 20 years old.**

RETRO:

According to Merriam Webster, retro is "relating to, reviving, or being the styles and especially the fashions of the past : fashionably nostalgic or old-fashioned." **Retro items may not actually be old but should reference styles of the recent past.**

MID CENTURY/MODERN:

Mid-century modern, or MCM as devotees call it in shorthand, was spawned from the Modernist movement. The guiding principle of the movement was function over fussiness, and making conceptual artistry attainable through everyday objects. The period between 1933-1965 would come to define a style that would become popularized and accessible to the masses, mid-century modern. So what are some defining characteristics of MCM? Sleek, cool, clean, sophisticated, functional, colorful, mod and curvy—those are apt words to describe mid-century modern design. **Mid-century modern is most closely associated with the period between the mid-1950s through the early 1960s. Think "Mad Men."**
